




Straight from the Horse's Mouth

I have attached a form to the end of this SFTHM edition and it's also available from the Events page on the Vic Branch website.



World Clydesdale Show

In 2012 I joined a few other Aussie Clydesdale enthusiasts and attended the Highland Show in Scotland, dropped in unexpectedly to Clydesdale farms in Eastern Canada and saw the spectacle of Clydesdales paraded in harness to a philharmonic orchestra at the Calgary Stampede. Aside from ticking a few things off the bucket list, this trip gave me an amazing opportunity to meet Clydesdale breeders in Scotland and Canada.

The World Clydesdale Show only happens once every four years and it's on again in 2015 from the 29th September to the 3rd October in London, Ontario, Canada.

Val Perkins is hoping to organise a trip in combination with Kingston Tours Australia to the World Clydesdale Show and is seeking expressions of interest from anyone keen to join in. A proposed itinerary is included to the right. Not only does it include the full extent of the show but ensures you make the most of your trip north-east by factoring in the rich and famous, carriage rides around Central Park and facing the Niagara Falls with a disposable spray jacket. 
Benalla Driving Day – Saturday 3rd May 2014
